Paul Mahoney began his veterinary career in mixed practice in Australia after graduating from the University of Sydney in 1984. After two years he moved to the UK where he worked in small animal practice for a further six years. Paul then spent a year studying for his Radiology Diploma at the Royal Veterinary College (RVC) and returned to Australia as Senior Registrar in Radiology at the University of Sydney Veterinary Teaching Hospital. Two years later he returned to the UK and provided imaging services to three small animal referral centres. In 2003, he returned to the RVC where he recently attained his European Diploma in Veterinary Diagnostic Imaging. While at the RVC Paul was appointed Director of their Clinical Extramural Studies (EMS) programme, a position that underlined to him the valuable role that practitioners continue to have in veterinary education across the UK. He left the imaging department at the RVC as Senior Lecturer in Veterinary Diagnostic Imaging in 2009 to begin his current position at the Willows Veterinary Centre and Referral Service.
